Dimensional Weight

All shipments are subject to a dimensional weight factor of 250 (I x w x h divided by 250), or the designated carrier's Density Minimum Charge.

Lift-gate/Delivery Notification (See Rate Sheet for Charges)

UPS Supply Chain Solutions will provide Lift-Gate Service & Delivery Notification. Notification of request must be prior to shipment dispatch.

Re-consignment or Diversions (See Rate Sheet for Charges)

UPS Supply Chain Solutions will provide re-consignment or diversion of scheduled delivery after dispatch services. Any storage charges incurred at an LTL or FTL facility due to re-consignment or diversion will be passed on to the client.

Refused Freight/Re-Delivery (See Rate Sheet for Charges)
